### **SYNOPSIS**

Ana, Cindy, Dulce and Valentina are four friends who have known each other since they were little girls, they are very different, but they complement each other. They work in a pineapple field and one day they discover that a mining company is polluting with impunity the river in their town where they usually swim and consequently the pineapple field where they work. They lose their job and all hope of a better life, so they decide to confront the company, but the more they fight, the more they realize just how much of an uphill battle they're facing, so they improvise a plan seeking justice.

They blackmail the director of the mining company with the self-kidnapping of his son, Daniel Jr. in exchange for stopping the pipe that pours toxic waste into the river, they believe that with this plan they are winning, but Daniel disappears, they believe that he has betrayed them. But everything changes when Daniel's body appears in the river. In the midst of the intrigue about who killed Daniel, the secrets between the friends come to light and create conflicts between them, jeopardizing further their friendship that is put to the test.

While the townspeople are divided, some see the mining company as the savior and others, who have been affected, protest for their presence. One of the girls, Ana, is accused of Daniel's death and is sent to jail, and they soon realize that justice is not the same for everyone, it seems that they are going to separate, and that the friendship is going to disappear. They realize that they cannot save the town this time, but they do can save their friendship. They end up uniting more strongly to help Ana and look for evidence that proves her innocence.

This is the story of four young women full of life advancing into adulthood, on a complex emotional journey where together they try to survive and fight for justice, where naivety confronts pride, and where hopelessness, like toxic waste in the water, affects the lives of everyone in the community.

#### **Human Nature:**

A story inspired on real events that narrates the consequences of water pollution on a small town that uses the river for everyday needs—from crop irrigation to bathing, to drinking water. Here are four Davids against a Goliath. Four young women against a great corporation that use their hunger for justice to fuel their determination.

As in life itself, things are won when lost, because deep down we know that the faith we have in the friendships we make is the only thing that stays with us when everything else falls apart.

This is the story of four young women who walk into adulthood knowing the inequality around them and have the willingness fight together for survival and justice at whatever the cost.

# **CHARACTERS**



### **ANA**

(19). Ana is a poet and a dreamer but keeps her feet on the ground. Even though sometimes her mind and heart start to daydream, so she ends up with a big secret she's been keeping from her friends. She always takes care of the others, she's the mom friend, always watching them.

The girls have known each other since childhood, they're basically family and have always lived in the town. Ana, unlike the others, has deep roots in her birthplace. She likes her town and wants to see it flourish, that's why she fights so hard to protect it, without realizing that they already lost the fight, even before knowing it was a fight.

### CINDY

(23). She's their leader. She makes decisions, and they follow her. She's impulsive and unpredictable, she's the mastermind of it all. She's very smart and intuitive, she knows how to convince people to obtain what she wants. She stays strong at the hardest moments and always rebels against status quo, that what keeps her going. She hides her feelings way too well and also keeps a secret from her friends. Her pragmatism makes her bow down to the imminent reality.

## **DULCE** —

(18). She's the youngest one. She's a dreamer, impulsive and materialistic. She dreams of becoming famous, imitating the women she sees on social media and on TV. She thinks money equals safety. That makes her hide some of her actions from her friends. However, she's loyal and loves her sister Ana. Her vibrant energy makes her stand out from the others and get all the attention wherever they go. She knows what she wants and is very confident about it, even if it means she'll have to go on by herself.

She's as impulsive as Cindy, so she makes some irreparable mistakes.

### VALENTINA —

(22). She's calm and does whatever the others tell her to do. She has a son and supporting parents, but she prefers her friends and belonging to the group instead, she loves being with Cindy, feeling protected and we will see why on the series.

She's good at avoiding her responsabilities and doesn't like to get in trouble. She didn't plan to become a mother, as she didn't plan anything else; she doesn't know how to take care of another human being. She can't even take care of herself.

He wants his son to stop behaving like a child, clubbing all the time, and worries for his future. He just wants for him to be be as successful as his father is.

### **DANIEL JR.** —

(19). The director's son. He lives a privilege life. He has a huge social media following and posts something everyday. He's a dreamer, kind-hearted and friendly, which makes him charming and very similar to his late mother. This is something his father dislikes, since he's trying to make him more thoughtful, strategic, serious which is good for business. Daniel likes to live in the moment with no commitments. He's single and into calm, humble, kind and submissive women that remind him of his mother. He just wants to have pleasant experiences, especially when it comes to women. He has a relationship that his father will not approve of, so he hides it.



## **CONCEPT**

Wonderland (El País de las Maravillas) is a Caribbean thriller, which takes place in the Dominican Republic, in a dense landscape, with a warm climate, small houses made of wood and zinc, surrounded by mountains, pineapple fields and a cristal clear river.

A coming of age, that happens in an idyllic town that has been transformed.

The general time structure uses flashbacks to show how the town went from being an amazing place to sick and bleak when the water pollution killed the fish, contaminated the land and forced hundreds to leave their homes.

In the present, we see the main characters' as a team with a common goal: stopping the toxic waste spill into the river. However, their egos, individual interests and personalities get in their way with a snowball effect, until they lose control of the situation.

As the story goes on, WONDERLAND shows us the characters' human duality: their wishes and values, but also their naivety and fears, all the while secrets destroy their friendship.

We will give protagonism to the antagonists and will witness how they face the problems. We let their human side arise. The company's director is shown as a man who's broken by his wife's early death and is full of fear as he struggles to get his most valuable treasure back: his son.

Police and Ministry of Environment appear to do their job and enforce law, which is not always fair, showing us the corruption happening in developing countries.

Besides that, authorities put in evidence the failures in the system and social media turn into a double-edged sword for everyone.

The story shows an atmosphere full of realism and suspense that keeps on growing on every episode and end up suddenly exploding at different moments, sometimes monumentously with disasterious results.

A social and dramatic plot that mixes a thriller full of secrets and romance, with only one goal: seeking justice for everyone in town.



## **SUMMARY**

### **CHAPTER I "Revenge for good"**

Four girls suspect the damage done to the river and the pineapple crops was caused by the pollution of a mining company. A self-kidnapping plan with Daniel, son of the director, will be an attempt to stop it. But his unexpected disappearance will completely change the situation.

#### **CHAPTER II "Forbidden fruit"**

Brussati demands to find Daniel's murderers.

#### CHAPTER IV "An eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth"

Ana is blamed for Daniel's murder. Dulce has a secret relationship with the mayor. Ana seeks refuge at a mountain close to Candy Town. Police is looking for her. Ana tries to figure out who actually killed Daniel. Gold Corporation starts with their plan of buying the town's homes. People are more pressured.

### **CHAPTER V "The King's fall"**

Ana is put in prison. The friends get together and look for a solution to stop Ana from getting a sentence. Dulce finds proof of Ana's innocence, but the mayor deletes it. The Gold Corporation goes on with their plan to turn Candy Town into a toxic wasteland and they give a deadline for the inhabitants to decide to sell their properties to the Corporation.

#### **CHAPTER VI "Separation"**

The friends try to look for a new solution and they find it together. Many people leave town due to the imminent destruction. The only thing that survives from the beautiful past is the girls' friendship. Despite each following their own path, we hang on the hope of them getting back together, stronger than before.


#### **NEXT SEASONS**

#### **SEASON 2:**




